

400-level Entry to Physiology Flow Chart

Late Nov:
applications are
filtered.
Students fall
into one of
three
categories:

Student is eligible and matched with a project supervisor

Student is eligible but waitlisted or unmatched with a project supervisor

Student does not meet the eligibility criteria

Early Dec: E-mail letters sent to students

Letter informing student that they are matched and accepted into the programme

Letter informing student that they are eligible but waitlisted/unmatched. Invitation to come back to Tracey to find another available supervisor

Letter informing student that they are ineligible

Late Dec/ early Jan: Professional course results released

Confirmed acceptance for 400-level entry

Waitlisted students take the place of those that accept professional course positions

Unmatched students do not follow up/ come back into the system

Student declines 400-level position to accept professional course position

No suitable matches are found, student is declined

Interested students come back into the system to meet with available supervisors

Find a match

No suitable match found
